Attachment Play - Aware Parenting Institute

Play Therapy in Middle Childhood

30 to 45 minutes Thus, play therapists usually prepare several play activities to keep children this age engaged during a 50-minute therapy session Their selective attention is also much better in middle childhood than earlier, meaning that they are capable of tuning out irrelevant distractions in order to pay attention to a task Play
